Qormi Wine Festival 2014



The last few days were dedicated to the final preparations for the 10th edition of the Qormi Wine Festival - the biggest two-day event held yearly in the streets of Citta' Pinto.

This year the Qormi Wine Festival will be held on Friday 5th and Saturday 6th September, from 7:30pm till very late. This two day national event held in Qormi has kept its place as the premier cultural event of this city, having a good reputation all over the island and even abroad.

On Sunday 31st August the organizers of the Qormi Wine Festival inaugurated the annual wine exhibition which is held in Rock Street, few meters away from the Parish Church dedicated to Saint George. This event kicks off a week full of celebrations and festivities in Citta' Pinto as this city celebrates the closing of the grapes harvesting season.

During this week hundreds of people from around the island will flock to Qormi to visit this unique exhibition which will be open for the days of the Wine Festival proper. Apart from this exhibition the festival will also feature a wine competition by local producers which is a highlight in its own. Infact, this competition brings together all local producers of home wines and has grown from year to year as the leading competition of its sort in Malta.

Over the weekend the streets will be dressed with special decorations while Maltese food will be served on Friday and Saturday.

The Qormi Wine Festival is supported by the Ministry for Tourism, the Parliamentary Secretary for Agriculture, Fisheries and Animal Rights, the Qormi Local Council and Marsovin.
